Medicare of Florida has electronic trading partner agreements with many private insurers to provide electronic transfer or “Automatic Crossover” of Medicare Part B claim information. The following insurers currently participate in the Medicare Part B electronic crossover program.

Note: Certain companies (*) function as a *CLEARINGHOUSE*, which provides Medicare with the eligibility to receive the crossover claim, and then forwards the claim to the supplemental insurer to process benefits.
